

### North Tyler Home Donated to Habitat

A rent house near the Habitat for Humanity of Smith County Tenneha Development in North Tyler was donated today to the organization.

Freedom Financial Group President Taylor White donated the house and land valued at \$35,000 to Habitat so they can build more affordable homes in the neighborhood.

Habitat has completed three of the six homes planned for the Tenneha Development and with this donation more homes can be built nearby.

The 109th home for Habitat for Humanity of Smith County is currently under construction.

“We are planning to build two more homes on Tenneha in the first half of 2020 and are currently looking for people who might qualify for a Habitat home,” said Jack Wilson, CEO of Habitat for Humanity of Smith County. “Homeowners purchase their home from Habitat with a no-profit, 30-year mortgage. Applicants must demonstrate the need for affordable housing and show the ability to make a monthly mortgage payment. More information is on our web site.”
