



### **Habitat for Humanity of Smith County Monopoly Tournament Rules:**

1. Players must be at least 9 years of age and up and able to play the game unassisted. No spectators will be allowed to coach or give advice during game play. Players will be randomly assigned to tables.
2. Games will be up to 60 minutes in length. A warning will be called when five minutes of play is left. If a player is in the middle of a play when time is called; they may finish their turn. The banker at the table will tabulate the results. Please leave all game pieces on the table and volunteers will reset the games.
3. A judge will make final decisions on any disputes during the game and their decision will be final.
4. After round one, the top player from each table will advance to the next round. Multiple rounds will be played. Prizes will be awarded to the top players.
5. The tournament will be played on a classic Monopoly game and play by the official rules. We will have a question/answer session before the first game.
6. A banker will be provided at each table.
7. No delay of game will be tolerated. Each player should be ready when it's their turn.
8. This is a family atmosphere. We ask that you watch your language, be gracious if you lose, and remember this is a fun event to raise money for a non-profit.
9. No family members will be allowed to play at the same table. Only if they make it to the final rounds and it cannot be avoided. Cheating will not be tolerated. Please remember this is a fundraiser.
10. Players must be on time to the rounds they are playing and if the game has already started and they were late they forfeit a chance to play in the game any further.
